

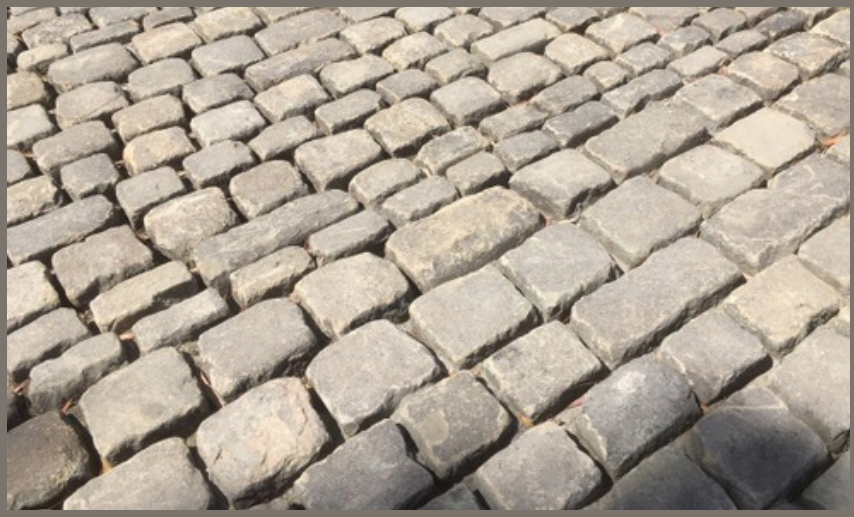


# Reclaimed Yorkshire Cobbles

# Product Information

- Random/mixed sizes 100/200mm wide x 100/300mm long x 150/250mm deep with tumbled edges circa 2.5m<sup>2</sup> per bulk bag. 15-18 linear metres per bag/pallet. All sizes are approximate.
- Coursed sizes 100/200mm wide x 125/200mm deep with tumbled edges circa 2.5m<sup>2</sup> per bulk bag. 15-18 linear metres per bag/pallet. All sizes are approximate.
- We advise that all natural stone should ideally be laid on a permeable drain mortar with permeable jointing compounds, with a minimum joint width of 3mm and a minimum depth of 20mm, or alternatively with a semi-dry sharp sand and cement mix (4:1) with a suitable bonding bridge
