- 45/60cm Coursed Lengths x Coursed Lengths x 30-80mm thickness. (min 23" - 26" random lengths)
- Mixed Widths x Random Lengths x 30-80mm thickness.
- We advise that all natural stone should ideally be laid on a permeable drain mortar with permeable jointing compounds, with a minimum joint width of 3mm and a minimum depth of 20mm, or alternatively with a semi-dry sharp sand and cement mix (4:1) with a suitable bonding bridge
